Fee Regulations

Every student has to pay the prescribed fees within the stipulated date. Students who have not paid the fees within the due date are liable to be removed from the college rolls. Holders of scholarships are also bound by these regulations.

Hostel Facility

Our College has separate hostel facilities for boys and girls. Strict discipline is maintained in the hostel. Students should take care of the hostel property. The cost of the damaged hostel property will be recovered from the students.

Hostel Fees will be paid at the time of reopening date. Students are advised to give their suggestions to the warden regarding food and other basic needs. Other details regarding fees deposits are given in the hostel application form.

Bus Facility

- The loss of any book- should be reported at once to the librarian.
- Books should be returned on or before the stamped date. A line of one rupee per day will be collected for delay in return.
- Students are asked to enter their name in the register before entering the library.

- In case of loss of books a fine amount and the cost of the book will be collected from the borrower.
- All "No Due" Certificates issued to the students should be counter signed by the librarian.
- Requisition slips for books required must be tendered between 9.30 A.M. and 12.00 Noon at the library.

Students have to follow the Instructions carefully before facing the University Theroy Examinations

1. Students must be to present in the examination hall 10 minutes before the commencement of Exam.
2. Without Hall ticket and Id-Card no candidate will be permitted to write the examinations.
3. If Hall Ticket & Id - Card are not available they have to get temporary Hall Ticket & Id -Card for that particular session by payment of Rs.25 for each session (Separately for Id-Card and Hall Ticket) Temporary Hall Ticket will be issued only after receiving the no due slip from the office for each session.
4. All the columns in the main sheets have to be properly filled and the attendance Register must be signed after entering of Answer Book number .
5. Use either blue or block ink for answering. Partly blue or black in have to be avoided.
6. Do not write anything on the question paper except Register Number
7. Students are permitted to leave the examination hall only after 12.30 PM in the morning sessions and 4.30 PM in the afternoon.
8. Students indulging in malpractice, will receive rigorous punishment as per the university norms and conditions.

Attention the of Students while writing University Examinations

Avoid invocatory signs such as Ramajayam, Om, 786, End., on the main sheet and additional sheet. If any such writing or marking is found on the answer sheet, the results will be withheld by the University.

Students should abstain from bringing bits of paper, scale and handkerchiefs etc., with pre-written answers.

- Prepare yourself well in advance for the University Examinations and avoid last minute study.
- Revise your lesson on a daily basis.
- Writing practice is very important from the very start of regular classes.
- Revise your answers.
- Avoid TV / Cinema show and Unncessary.

- Fix your goal and work hard to reach it.
