4.4.2 There are established systems and procedures for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities – laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc.

1) Science Laboratories:

The College has wel-established and functioning laboratories for physical science, chemical science, computer science and English language. Lab assistants have been employed in adequate numbers in order to maintain the laboratories and help the students. Stocks, equipment and lab safety measures are periodically verified by the concerned department staf. Lab in charges have been nominated from each concerned department for this purpose. Students attendance, stock register and breakage register are maintained scrupulously. Stock supply, equipment repair/maintenance and breakage replacements are done well at the beginning of each and every semester without fail. Chemicals, physics apparatus and computer components are ordered and purchased from the authorised company based on the needs as prescribed in syllabus. The purchase committee has been entrusted with procuring the best quality stocks and equipment for the laboratories.

2) Library:

The College has a state-of-the-art library equipped with thousands of books, digital subscriptions, electronic materials, computer network and helping staff. The librarian maintains separate registers for staff and student visitors. Borrowing books has been simplified through the digital library system. Students are provided full access to the stack books, reference material, journals and electronic resources on all the days except Sundays and national holidays. A separate reading hall has been allocated for the students to bring in their own books/materials and read them without any distraction. The book purchase committee is headed by the college librarian, and it consists of the principal, vice principal and department heads. List of books and reference materials are duly obtained on each academic year from all departments by consolidating every faculty member and student representative's suggestions. Those suggestions are thoroughly considered and approved by the book purchase committee, after which they are procured by the college management. The college library effectively coordinates with the IT personals for the maintenance of computers and software programs. It also works closely with all the departments in order for them to allocate extra library visiting hours for the students and to motivate them to use the library resources.

3) Sports Complex:

The college hosts various sports tournaments for the Annamalai University and Thiruvalluvar University at the inter-collegiate and inter-divisional levels, being the top contributor for sports activities in the Kalllakurichi district. Physical director ensures the proper maintenance of both the indoor and outdoor sports complexes. Athletic tracks, cricket pitch, badminton court and other playing fields are kept intact by the support staff of the physical education department.

4) Computers:

The college has installed more than 250 computers with proper software applications, networking and hardware facilities. The system maintenance staff promptly attend to any defect in the computers and resolve the same at the earliest. Students of computer science and computer application courses have been allocated separate computer labs, while other students make use of the common computer centre and library systems. The computer labs have also been equipped with Internet, Air condition, and UPS facilities.

5) Classrooms:

The college has zero tolerance for any defect or discomfort in the classroom infrastructure. Spacious classrooms have been equipped with sufficient furniture, blackboards, smartboards, electrical lights, fans, windows and ventilation to open air. Students are constantly encouraged to maintain their classrooms clean, and appealing. Projectors and window curtains are also made available to the classrooms as and wen required. Any fault in the electrical items or defect in the furniture are immediately reported by the class representatives, and such issues are attended to at the earliest.

6) Power generation and energy conservation:

The College is committed not only to preserve electrical power, but also develop its power generation capacity to meet its entire energy requirement. Efforts to this end also includes the college's conviction to produce maximum power from renewable sources. Presently, all buildings are connected through a 125 KVA power generator, 6 UPS with 5KVA, 2 UPS with 7.5 KVA, 3 UPS with 3KVA to provide uninterrupted power supply. The college has also installed six solar lights with 22 W capacity at important locations inside the campus.

7) Water Supply:

Quality drinking water is supplied to the students and staff in the college campus without any interruption. High-capacity reverse Osmosis (RO) water plants have been installed and regularly

maintained for ensuring clean and safe water supply. Clean water derived from borewells and open wells is supplied for usage in laboratories, toilets and for various other purposes.

8) Sewage Treatment:

The College ensures to recycle the wastage water that is free from chemical ingredients. An effective sewage treatment plan has been put in place by which the waste is segregated and the discharged water is used in the garden and in the toilets.

9) Medical Facilities:

The college is situated nearby a pharmacy college that offers paramedical courses, which is part of Dr. R. K. Shanmugam group of educational institutions. Hence, immediate first-aid and preliminary medical care is provided to the students and staff members. As an added advantage, many of our college executive directors are medical practitioners themselves. They visit the institution every week and provide required medical care to the needed students and staff. The College has also established a dynamic network with local hospitals which provide ambulance facilities in case of emergency.

10) Rainwater Harvesting:

Rainwater Harvesting plants have been created at the crucial points within the campus. These plants are properly maintained from time-to-time..


11) Parking Facilities:


Adequate parking facilities for bicycles, motorized two wheelers and four-wheelers are available at various locations inside the campus. Students and staff members have been allocated different parking locations.


12) Hostel:


